## Living Prairie Child Care

Anticipated to open July 2019, Living Prairie Child Care is a designated Qualico worksite child care centre. It will create 74 licensed child care spaces for children of Qualico employees and residents of Sage Creek, and is independently operated by Living Prairie Child Care Inc.

The 74 child care spaces will include 20 infant spots and 54 preschool spots. The daycare is located at 215 Boulevard des Hivernants North, near the roundabout at Edward Turner Drive.

Qualico has been working on this daycare centre for more than six years, and is pleased to assist, in partnership with the Province of Manitoba, in creating 74 new daycare spaces that will serve people who either live or work in Sage Creek.



# Grey Heron Rise Grey Heron Rise is a new luxu

Grey Heron Rise is a new luxury condo development in Sage Creek by Dobie Properties. It will be the first multi-family site in Phase 8 located on Grey Heron Drive.

The 22-unit town home condominium project boasts stunning wetland views and walk- out lower levels. Starting at \$399,900, the first units will be under construction in the next few months.

### Latitude 49 at Sage Creek

This complex will include six buildings, ranging from three to six stories in height. The units offer a mix of micro-units, single bedroom and double bedroom options.

The three-story building (along Burning Glass Road) will offer ground level commercial spaces for future tenants. There will be a mix of underground and surface parking, which will offer a few carports as well. The apartments have something for everyone, with on-site amenities such as a club house, pool, outdoor BBQs, fire pit, gym, lounge, and a private dog park.

The site is also immediately adjacent to the Village Centre shops, restaurants, and services. We can expect to see the first buildings completed in early 2020 with the full complex set to complete Summer 2021, pending any unforeseen circumstances.

As families walked throughout the various exhibitions, they observed numerous types of learning showcasing students' progress in literacy, numeracy, sciences, social studies, human rights, and art.

Although we are extremely proud of the students' final work, we also showcased various stages of the different projects; from the initial brainstorming, planning, drafting and editing that leads to a final product or performance – to show the process that students follow to go from an initial idea to its conclusion.

# Parent Advisory Council Update

#### Sandra-Dee Beer

The Parent Advisory Council was created at École Sage Creek School in September of 2017 when the school first opened. We have had a busy year and a half establishing our mission, and creating events and initiatives for within the school and for the community.

Over 87% of school-aged children that live in Sage Creek attend school at ÉSCS. That's currently 727 students! The school was originally built for just 600 and after only a few months it was over capacity.

Starting in the Fall of 2019 the Louis Riel School Division (LRSD) has made the decision to change the age configuration of the school to K-6, from the K-8 it currently is (and was built for).

As a result, all grade 7 and 8 students will be attending their respective high schools, Collège Béliveau and Windsor Park Collegiate, earlier than grade 9 as originally planned.

LRSD continues to request that another elementary school be built in Sage Creek to accommodate all current students and the continued growth in the area. However, at this point in time the Province will not be funding another school in Sage Creek. What this means for current families, future families and homeowners in the area is that the school we have now will continue to reduce its grade structure, down to a K-4 or even a K-3. More students will be bused out of the area.

As a Parent Advisory Council, we are trying to inform all residents about this issue and asking for your input and support to have another elementary school built in Sage Creek.

The school's history and current overpopulation status has been documented on our PAC website at <a href="https://www.sagecreekpac.com">www.sagecreekpac.com</a>. I encourage you to read through some of the questions and answers, and to sign up to receive information going forward.

The Provincial government has established a Commission to review Kindergarten to Grade 12 Education in Manitoba.

It is an opportunity for parents, organizations, students, and the general public to share their views and opinions on: student learning, teaching, accountability for student learning, governance, and funding.

We would like to contribute to the review as an organization and look at other possibilities on how we can push to have another school built here in Sage Creek. If you are interested in joining the discussions, or would like to help but don't know what to do or say, please sign up on our website to learn more.

The submissions to the Commission are accepted until May 30<sup>th</sup>. Our goal is to have a community meeting prior to the submission deadline. Please consider joining us to make all taxpayers and homeowners in Sage Creek aware of the imminent concern of elementary education in our community.

All current and future homeowners in Sage Creek deserve to know the plan for elementary education here. Too many assumptions were made (myself included) that our children would attend school in their neighbourhood. We have a right to know the long-term plan to make the decisions that are best for our families, as homeowners and taxpayers.

Plans for our second Run Sage Creek are underway! After a successful first RSC last October we're registered with Manitoba Runners' Association to host our annual event on October 13th this year!


